SUFFRAGISTS from every corner of Massachusetts and bordering states will assemble on this spot, memorable as the birth-place of our pioneer worker, on Saturday, August 14th.

The house where Lucy Stone was born stands on Coy's Hill, the highest point in Massachusetts east of Mt. Tom and south of Wachusett.

At about one o'clock the Pilgrims will arrive. There will be a picnic lunch under the trees, and fresh milk will be on sale. At two o'clock Miss Blackwell will arrive—and this will be the signal for the commencement of the afternoon's program which will have for its special features the planting of the Campaign Tree and the unveiling of the bronze tablet to be placed on the house by Massachusetts Suffragists.

Many distinguished guests will be present and speak.

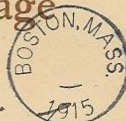
Automobile Procession
