

Maria Louisa S. Firth of Leicester, Massachusetts

Born: c. 1822. Maria Firth was 28 years old at the time of the 1850 National Woman's Rights Convention in Worcester, Massachusetts.

Died: 1860; buried in Pine Grove Cemetery in Leicester.

Married: To Abraham Firth (c. 1818-1886), a railroad agent with \$500 in personal property in 1850. He was born in England

Children: Frank R. Firth (1847-1872) and Ellery Firth, who lived only 2 days.

Mr. Firth was guardian of the poor house and a member of the Worcester County Anti Slavery Society South Division. He also was president of the Freedom Club.
