

## Lewis Ford of Abington, Massachusetts

Born: 1812. Lewis Ford was 38 years old at the time of the 1850 National Woman's Rights Convention held in Worcester, Massachusetts.

Died:

Married: Anna Dyer of Braintree, 25 August 1833 (intended)

Children: Lewis Whitman Ford (3 March 1837 - 26 September 1839); Ann Frances Ford (2 November 1839 - 4 September 1840); Wilson Ford (10 November 1841 -); and Amanda Ford (2 February 1845 -).

Also residing in the Ford household in 1850 was Bridget Bailey, a 17-year-old born in Ireland. She was most likely a servant.

Mr. Ford was a Garrisonian abolitionist who once gave a speech at a capital punishment meeting.

Antoinette Brown stayed with the Fords in 1851.
