

Olive W. Hastings of Lancaster, Massachusetts

Born: c. 1811. Olive Hastings was 39 years old at the time of the 1850 National Woman's Rights Convention held in Worcester, Massachusetts.

Died:

Married: Samuel Hastings on 9 March 1832. In 1850, he was a 45-year-old carpenter with \$1,400 in personal property.

Children: Laura L. Hastings, who was 11 years old in 1850.

Henry Layter (?), a 24-year-old laborer born in Ireland
