

John B. Willard of Westford, Massachusetts

Born: 1 April 1822 in New York City, son of Luther and Mary Davis Willard. John Willard was 28 years old when he attended the 1850 National Woman's Rights Convention held in Worcester, Massachusetts.

Died: In Harvard, Massachusetts

Mr. Willard was a Congregationalist minister with a degree from Brown University. Reverend Willard accepted the ministry at the First Parish Church after the congregation split on 19 March 1848. He resigned from the parish in 1 December 1850 following the Woman's Rights Convention. He then moved to Windsor, Vermont.
